The HHP Farmers' Club is 100% volunteer managed and vital to our existence.

Many of our volunteer needs support our Farmers Market. Income from our Farmers market helps keep our plot rental fees low. This income helps pay for new equipment; repair/maintain existing farm equipment; irrigation system maintenance/repair; farm building maintenance/repairs, etc.

Some of our volunteer needs are listed below.

1. Farm Club Common Plots (help plant, pull weeds and harvest produce)
2. Spring/Summer Market Sales, May-July, Saturday a.m. (help set up, sell vegetables and clean up)
3. Citrus Grove (pull weeds, insect spray, roto-till around the perimeter, prune trees, harvest fruit)
4. Winter Market Sales, November – December, Saturday a.m., (help set up, sell, and clean up)
5. Orchard (prune trees, insect spray, fertilize, harvest)
6. Mowing Team (help mow the farm area; commitment 2 times per mowing season)
7. Plot Maintenance (help roto-till and weed abandoned plots)
8. Irrigation Committee (help maintain the irrigation system)
9. Equipment Maintenance (keep farm equipment operational)
10. Blueberries (weed, fertilize and harvest)
11. Dinner/Meeting (help host, set up, decorate, and clean up)
12. Spring /Fall Cleanup (trash removal, clean up and repairs)
13. Committee Chair (See Board directory for list of committees)
